

## A lot of Nutella

Costco has a new product on the shelves. You can now buy nearly 7 pounds (6.6 pounds) of **nutella** in a bucket.

That's a lot of **nutella**!

**Nutella** is a delicious, sweet, chocolaty hazelnut spread that I use to make dessert crepes.

Here's my simple crepe build. I use an 8-inch crepe (8-inches in diameter, crepes are circular), about 2 tablespoons of **nutella** and 1/3 of a banana to form this yummy dessert.

**Important Info!** According to the **nutella** nutritional facts label, 1 Tablespoon = 19 grams. This **nutella** bucket weighs 3 kilograms.
